#### MESSAGE FROM YOUR PRESIDENT KEN BACCETTI



As I sit at my computer and type this month's President's message, I would like to bring you the latest information on the striped bass slot limit petition of 18" to 30" that was heard by the California Fish and Game Commission's (FGC) on Wednesday, August 13, 2025. The FGC forwarded the petition to the October 8, 2025 FGC meeting for a final vote. The FGC meeting will be held on October 8th at the East End Complex Auditorium, 1500 Capital Avenue, Sacramento, CA 95814. The meeting's agenda has this petition scheduled as agenda item #14, so it will likely be heard after lunch. It is imperative that all members of our Chapter attend this meeting in person, if you are able, to show support for the 18" to 30" striped bass slot limit. The "Striped Bass Coalition" of which we are a member will

have representation at this meeting to speak in favor of this petition. It will be at this meeting that the FGC will vote to adopt this rule change or not. If the FGC votes to adopt this rule change, it will go into effect on January 1, 2026. In the meantime, we are asking our members and their friends to please send emails to the Fish and Game Commission and tell the Commissioners that you support the 18" to 30" slot limit. Their email is: FGC@fgc.ca.gov.

Even though this very important FGC meeting is taking place the same day as our regular meeting day, we are NOT cancelling our Board meeting, dinner, general meeting and seminar. Since we will be just 2 days from the Rio Vista Striped Bass Derby and Festival, it is imperative that we meet to discuss our staffing and "weigh masters" responsibilities for the derby. If there is anyone who would like to volunteer to work at the derby's weigh station, please contact President Baccetti or Vice-President Mike Phillips. The weigh station will be open Friday, October 10th and Saturday, October 11th from 9am to 6pm, and Sunday, October 12th from 9am to 3pm with the winners announced at 4pm at the steps of Rio Vista City Hall. If you would like to register to fish the derby, or if you would like more information on the derby and festival go to www.bassfestival.com.

At our September 10, 2025 meeting I, President Baccetti, announced our fishing contest winner for September 2025. The winner was Jimmy Bondoc. Congratulations Jimmy! Remember, all Isleton Delta Chapter members in good standing are eligible to enter one monthly photo for our fishing photo contest. So, if you're a member in good standing of our chapter, text your fishing success photo with your name included to President Ken Baccetti at 415-602-1298. All photos received will be included in our monthly newsletters, on the Isleton link of the CSBA website, and on our Instagram page. The next Grand Prize will be chosen on June 10, 2026, so text me your fishing success photos to possibly be next year's Grand Prize winner.

Well, it's election time again, and our Nomination Chairman has been selected for our annual election. Our Nomination Chairman is Jim Cox. Jim will be contacting all current Officers and Board Members whose terms are expiring at the end of 2025 to determine their individual statuses going forward. Now for a membership report. Membership Director Kathy Baccetti tells me that since last month we have signed on 3 new commercial members and 2 new regular members. If you'd prefer to join via the US Mail, you can print our Isleton Chapter application off the membership link of the website, fill it out, and mail your check or credit card information to the Isleton address listed. All new members receive an Isleton Chapter hat and 2 Isleton Chapter decals, and previous members that renew receive an Isleton Chapter decal, all as a thank you for being a member.

In closing, I hope to see you on Wednesday, October 8th at our next dinner, meeting and seminar and at the Rio Vista Striped Bass Derby and Festival on October 10th, 11th, and 12th. We will be at the weigh station in front of Rio Vista City Hall all 3 days. Come by and say hello, and I wish you good luck if you're fishing the derby.

### FISHING REPORT



The striper bite for trollers in the Delta continues to be good according to our Isleton Board Member and avid trolling expert Mark Wilson. Mark tells me that he and his friends have been trolling in a number of locations until they locate the fish. They've trolled from the West Bank below the Rio Vista Bridge on the outgoing tide to the bottom of the tide with deep diving Yozuri lures, and on the San Joaquin River from Eddo's Marina to the Antioch Bridge and into Broad Slough using shallow running Yozuri's on the incoming tide for their best action. Mark continued to tell me that on his last trip he and his friends caught 20 keepers, only retaining their limits. Green or pink colored Yozuri's did the job on this trip.

If you'd like to troll for stripers on the Napa River from Cuttings Wharf, then our Isleton Commercial Member Guide Dennis Grossi of Grossi's Guide Service is the person you need to call. Dennis continues to get limits of stripers for his clients on each trip. Dennis tells me that he's been trolling 1 ounce Rat-L-Traps in the sloughs and at the mouth of the sloughs. The last hour of the outgoing tide and on the turn to the incoming tide has been best. Dennis went on to say that the fish have been averaging about 5 pounds.

There is no sturgeon report this month as sturgeon fishing closed on June 30th, but the good news is that sturgeon fishing will resume again on October 1, 2025 as a catch and release fishery, so look for a sturgeon report once again next month.

If you'd like to fish for limits of trout, then our Isleton Commercial Member Captain Kyle Wise of HeadHunter Sportfishing is who you need to contact. Capt. Kyle has been getting limits and early limits of beautiful rainbow trout at New Melones Lake for his clients. He tells me that he's trolling T-Spoons and Speedy Shiners smeared with Pautzke's Garlic and Herring Fire Gel in 70 to 100 feet of water while trolling at 2.4 to 2.8 MPH. Capt. Kyle further told me that he's still catching an occasional Kokanee on each trip as well, and catfish are also biting if you'd like to fish for them.

If you'd prefer to fish a potluck trip at Lake Berryessa, then call our Isleton Commercial Member Captain Nate Kelsch of Big Nates Guide Service. Capt. Nate tells me that he's been putting his customers on big Kokanee and King Salmon lately. Capt. Nate tells me that on his last trip the largest Kokanee caught was 20" and his largest King Salmon tipped the scale at 5 pounds. Capt. Nate continued by saying he's been trolling .8 to 1.3 MPH in 35 to 91 feet of water with Catch America 6" Offset Dodger's and T-Pexs' from the "Kokanee Kit" tipped with Chrome Killer Corn.

Now for a report from San Francisco Bay and out the Golden Gate. Our Isleton Commercial Member Captain Craig Hansen of Argo Sportfishing tells me that he's been drifting and fishing at anchor at Angel Island finding limits of stripers on both the incoming and outgoing tides. Capt. Craig continued to tell me that once he limits out on stripers, he tries to locate halibut or rockfish depending on what his clients would prefer. Capt. Craig shared that he's still finding a few halibut at Angel Island, the front side of Alcatraz, and the Berkeley Flats on either tide. If his customers want rockfish, he's been navigating out the Golden Gate and is locating a variety of rockfish at Bonita Cove.

Meanwhile, our Isleton Commercial Member Captain Ron Koyasako of Nautilus Excursions told me that he's been putting his clients on striped bass chumming with live bait at Angel Island. Capt. Ron continued to say that once he limits out on stripers he's been heading out the Golden Gate and finding an excellent grade of rockfish off the Marin Coast for his customers.

# RECIPE OF THE MONTH – October 2025 STRIPED BASS CAKES (LIKE CRAB CAKES BUT W/STRIPER)

#### **INGREDIENTS**

5lb striped bass filet

3 raw eggs

½ large green pepper

1 small white onion

3/4 cup unseasoned breadcrumbs

3 cloves minced fresh garlic

3 tablespoons chopped fresh basil

1 teaspoon Kosher salt

1 teaspoon fresh ground black pepper

3 tablespoons Dijon mustard

3 tablespoons Worcestershire sauce

1 tablespoon Old Bay seasoning

#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

Cut all of the red meat out of the fish, as this is the part that tastes fishy. Bring a pot of salted water to a rolling boil, then boil the striped bass for about 8 minutes, and immediately transfer the filets to an ice water bath to stop them from cooking. This will keep the fish from overcooking once you are finished boiling it, and it helps maintain a firm consistency. Hold the filets in the ice water bath for approximately 10 minutes. While the striper is chilling, finally mince the green pepper, onion, garlic and basil. Combine the vegetables and garlic with the rest of the ingredients, except the fish, in a large mixing bowl. Once the striper is finished chilling, cut it into very small pieces, not giant chunks. Make small hamburger sized patties out of the mixture, sprinkle them lightly with Old Bay, and then pan fry them in olive oil on medium high heat for approximately 4 minutes per side or until nice and brown (don't overcook them). When they are finished squeeze a little bit of fresh lemon over the top of them and serve them with your favorite sides and Chardonnay.
