MESSAGE FROM YOUR PRESIDENT KEN BACCETTI



As I sit and type this month's President's message, I would like to let you know the outcome of the striped bass slot limit petition of 18" to 30" that was voted on by the California Fish and Game Commission's (FGC) on Wednesday, October 8, 2025 in Sacramento. The petition was listed as agenda item #14, and the "Striped Bass Coalition" was originally told when the agenda was announced that the striper agenda item was going to be heard at 130pm. On Tuesday, October 7th, the day before the meeting, we were advised by FGC staffers that we should be available at 11am on Wednesday, October 8th. Coalition members arrived by 11am only to wait as the Commission heard 2 other agenda items. It was then at 1150am that FGC President Zavaleta stated that the Commissioners were going to break for lunch. President Zavaleta then asked the other Commissioners if they objected to hear another agenda item out of turn upon their return from lunch that will take approximately 2 hours. The Commissioners didn't object to this request and agreed to hear this 2-hour agenda item upon

their return. Because of this delay in hearing the striped bass agenda item this writer had to depart for Rio Vista to set up the Veteran's Hall for our important Board meeting, dinner, general meeting, and seminar beginning at 430pm that afternoon. Vice-President Mike Phillips remained to represent our Isleton Chapter. CSBA State Board President Jim Cox and CSBA West Delta President Roger Mammon and some regular CSBA regular members remained to speak in favor of the petition. Unfortunately, after hearing from numerous in-person coalition members and Zoom callers the Commission voted 3 to 2 against the petition. Voting no were Commissioners Zavaleta, Murray and Sklar, and voting yes in favor were Commissioners Anderson and Hostier-Carmesin. This unfavorable vote didn't sit well with us as you can only imagine, as the "Striped Bass Coalition" has been working diligently on this petition for years. All I can personally say is we should, as responsible anglers, voluntarily release all striped bass measuring 30 inches or more. We all need to sustain the striped bass population for current and future generations.

Well, the 77th Rio Vista Striped Bass Derby and Festival is in the books. As you probably already knew the derby was held on Friday, October 10th and Saturday, October 11th from 9am to 6pm, and Sunday, October 12th from 9am to 3pm with the winners announced at 4pm at the steps of Rio Vista City Hall. We were again asked to be the weighmasters this year. The derby was well received and I'm pleased to say that every child who turned in either a striper or catfish went home with a prize. I would like to thank the following members who volunteered to work the derby. They are Randal Arbini, Denise Boos, Diana Canevaro, Michael Casdia, and Mark Wilson. I would be remiss if I didn't thank Board Member Dan Neihart and Vice-President Mike Phillips who volunteered to work with yours truly from Friday morning's opening to Sunday's derby awards ceremony. Without all these individuals volunteering the derby wouldn't have been possible. Thank you!

If you recall, in June of this year I announced that Mark Wilson was honored by Mixed Bag Sportsman by presenting him with their "Legends Award." Well, I am pleased to say that Mixed Bag Sportsman has now awarded our very own Clyde Wands with their "Legends Award." Clyde has been a member of our Chapter since its inception. Clyde has held numerous positions in our Chapter, just recently stepping down as a Board Member just prior to his 92nd birthday. Clyde's contributions to the striped bass fishery, and fishing in general, is legendary. He even has a shoal above the East side of the Rio Vista Bridge respectfully named for him by fellow fisherman. We are honored to have Clyde as an "Honorary Member" of our Isleton Chapter, and I know I can speak for all of us when I congratulate Clyde Wands for receiving the "Mixed Bag Sportsman's Legends Award."

At our September 10, 2025 meeting I, President Baccetti, announced our fishing contest winner for October 2025. The winner was Steve Leulholtz. Congratulations Steve! Remember, all Isleton Delta Chapter members in good standing are eligible to enter one monthly photo for our fishing photo contest. So, if you're a member in good standing of our chapter, text your fishing success photo with your name included to President Ken Baccetti at 415-602-1298. All photos received will be included in our monthly newsletters, on the Isleton link of the CSBA website, and on our Instagram page. The next Grand Prize will be chosen on June 10, 2026, so text me your fishing success photos to possibly be next year's Grand Prize winner.

Well, it's election time again, and our Nomination Chairman has been selected for our annual election. Our Nomination Chairman is Jim Cox. Jim will be contacting all current Officers and Board Members whose terms are expiring at the end of 2025 to determine their individual statuses going forward. Nominations will close on Wednesday, November 12, 2025 at 7pm, the evening of our next meeting.

If you'd prefer to join via the US Mail, you can print our Isleton Chapter application off the membership link of the website, fill it out, and mail your check or credit card information to the Isleton address listed. All new members receive an Isleton Chapter hat and 2 Isleton Chapter decals, and previous members that renew receive an Isleton Chapter decal, all as a thank you for being a member.

In closing, I hope to see you on Wednesday, November 12th for our next dinner, meeting and turkey and ham raffle. Until next month, good luck on the water.

FISHING REPORT



The striper bite for trollers in the Delta has been very slow lately according to our Isleton Board Member and trolling expert Mark Wilson. Mark tells me that he and his friends have been navigating all over the Delta trying to locate the now elusive stripers. Mark continued to say that he finally located a few in Montezuma Slough trolling from the "Glass House" to the "Birds Landing" areas, but he and his friends have only been able to get 3 to 6 keepers a trip trolling both deep diving and shallow running P-Line and Yozuri lures. Mark went on to say that he has heard that those casting swim baits have been doing somewhat better. The areas producing for those casting are Sherman Island and in Broad Slough. Mark believes that it's just a matter of time before the stripers arrive back in the Delta from San Francisco and San Pablo Bavs.

If you'd like to troll for stripers on the Napa River from Cuttings Wharf, then our Isleton Commercial Member Captain Dennis Grossi's Guide Service has a report for you. Unlike Mark Wilson's report, Capt. Dennis tells me that he's putting his customers on limit fishing. Capt. Dennis is averaging 25 hook-ups a trip, with stripers averaging 5 pounds up to 10 pounds. One ounce Rat-L-Traps continue to be his lure of choice.

The sturgeon catch and release fishery opened again on October 1, 2025. If you'd like to get worn out catching these big dinosaurs then call our Isleton Commercial Member Captain Mike Funtanilla of Bend Ur Rod Sportfishing. Capt. Mike told me that he has been putting his clients on multiple hookups on each trip. Capt. Mike went on to say that he's been doing well from Pittsburg and the Middle Grounds in 25 feet of water, as well as in 55 to 75 feet of water in the deepwater channel. Roe continues to be the bait of choice. Capt. Mike has also been soaking grass shrimp on these same trips for stripers, so his customers can enjoy catching a striper as well.

If you'd like to fish for trout, then call our Isleton Commercial Member Captain Kyle Wise of HeadHunter Sportfishing. Capt. Kyle tells me that the kokanee bite is over at New Melones Lake, so he's switched over to trolling for trout. He tells me that while the bite isn't wide open, he's catching a few trout for those customers wanting to chase them. Capt. Kyle continued to tell me that he's trolling T-Spoons and Speedy Shiners in 40 feet of water, trolling at 2.5 knots. Catfish are biting if you'd like to fish for them.

Now for a couple of reports from San Francisco Bay. Our Isleton Commercial Member Captain Craig Hansen of Argo Sportfishing tells me that he's been drifting live bait with his clients for limits of stripers at both Angel Island and Raccoon Strait. Capt. Craig continued to tell me that once he limits out on stripers, he's been navigating to the San Francisco side of the South Bay for a few keeper halibut. Capt. Craig hasn't been going out the Golden Gate chasing rockfish lately because of the large swells.

Meanwhile our Isleton Commercial Member Captain Ron Koyasako of Nautilus Excursions told me that he's been having his customers drift live bait and jig spoons for limits of striped bass at Red Rock, Raccoon Strait and at Angel Island. Capt. Ron continued to say that stripers have been at most of all the popular locations in the bay lately.

Lastly, the word on live bait is that J and P Bait will be open Fridays through Mondays 6am to 9am, and will be closed Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays until the season for them closes the second week on November.

RECIPE OF THE MONTH – November 2025 DUNGENESS CRAB CAKES

INGREDIENTS

1 lb. Dungeness crab meat, picked over for shells

1/4 cup breadcrumbs (Panko or regular - your choice)

2 tablespoons mayonnaise

1 large egg, beaten

1 tablespoon Dijon mustard

1 teaspoon Worcestershire sauce

1 tablespoon fresh lemon juice

1/4 cup finely chopped green onions

1 tablespoon freshly chopped Italian parsley

1/2 teaspoon Old Bay seasoning

Salt & pepper to taste

1 tablespoon olive oil and 1 tablespoon butter (for frying)

Lemon wedges, for serving

INSTRUCTIONS

Prepare the crab cake mixture in a large mixing bowl, by gently combining the crab meat, breadcrumbs, mayonnaise, the beaten egg, Dijon mustard, Worcestershire sauce, lemon juice, green onions, chopped Italian parsley, Old Bay seasoning, salt and pepper. Mix until just combined, being careful not to break up the crab meat too much. Form the crab cakes by dividing the mixture into 6 – 8 equal portions and shape them into patties about 1 inch thick. Place the crab cakes on a plate and refrigerate for 30 minutes to firm them up. Heat the olive oil and butter in a large skillet over medium heat. Once hot, carefully add the crab cakes to the pan, cooking for 3 – 4 minutes on each side, until golden brown and crispy. When done, remove the crab cakes from the skillet and drain them on a paper towel-lined plate. Serve immediately with the lemon wedges or your favorite sauce such as tartar sauce. Enjoy the flavorful Dungeness crab cakes with a tossed green salad or roasted vegetables for a complete meal. We normally enjoy this dish with our favorite Sauvignon Blanc wine.


Thank You Captain Dennis Grossi
