

## FISHING REPORT



The stripers bite for trollers in the Delta continues to be very slow according our Isleton Board and new Lifetime Member Mark Wilson. Mark tells me that this past week he, and another legendary fisherman our Isleton Lifetime Member Clyde Wands, decided to give bait fishing a try since trolling for stripers hasn't been productive. Mark continued to tell me that they anchored in 21 feet off of Chain Island and then afterwards near channel marker 14 using sardines for bait. The water temperature was 48 degrees, but as Mark said it, it was colder than that all day sitting in a boat. Mark went on to say that they only caught 3 keepers to 8 pounds and a few shakers all day. Mark did add that a few of his friends have been doing well at the Port of

Sacramento drifting minnows and trolling Yozuri deep diving and Berkley Dredger deep diving crankbaits.

If chasing sturgeon on the Delta is what you'd like to pursue, then call our Isleton Commercial Member Captain Mike Funtanilla of Bend Ur Rod Sportfishing. Capt. Mike told me that he's been targeting sturgeon with his clients at Chain Island and in Honker Bay, both in approximately 18 to 25 feet of water. Capt. Mike shared that on a recent trip this week his customers boated 8 sturgeon and some bonus stripers to 8 pounds. Capt. Mike continued to say that salmon roe enticed both the sturgeon and stripers.


If you'd like to fish for rainbow trout on New Melones Lake, then call our Isleton Commercial Member Captain Kyle Wise of HeadHunter Sportfishing. Capt. Kyle tells me that he's been putting his customers on a wide-open trout bite for some time. Capt. Kyle told me that he's been trolling white spoons in the top 20 feet of water for trout averaging 18 inches. The surface water temperature has been averaging 56 degrees.

If fishing on Lake Berryessa for rainbow trout is what you'd prefer, then our Isleton Commercial Member Captain Nate Kelsch of Big Nate's Guide Service has a report for you. Capt. Nate tells me that he's been putting his customers on limits of rainbow trout for an incredible 120 straight days. Capt. Nate went on to say that been trolling Trigger Spoons, Junior Trigger Spoons, and Trix Minnows all in shad patterns in the top 25 feet of water. Most of the trout are averaging 1 1/2 pounds to his recent best of 5 1/2 pounds.

Now for a couple of reports from San Pablo Bay and out the Golden Gate. Our Isleton Commercial Member Captain Craig Hansen of Argo Sportfishing tells me that he's been navigating from his berth at Fisherman's Wharf with his customers and anchoring on the west side of San Pablo Bay. With live bait no longer available, Capt. Craig is now soaking tray bait anchovies for a very good stripers bite. Capt. Craig continued to say that his clients are also catching some flounders and leopard sharks as well. Most of his best action has been on the incoming tides.

Meanwhile, our Commercial Member Captain Ron Koyasako of Nautilus Excursions told me that when ocean conditions cooperate, he's been travelling out the Golden Gate with his customers targeting rockfish and Dungeness crab. Capt. Ron tells me that he first navigates to the crab grounds and drops his hoop nets in 186 to 200 feet of water before heading to the Farallon Islands for an excellent rockfish and lingcod bite. After approximately 1 1/2 hours at the Farallon's, Capt. Ron returns to the crab grounds to pull the hoop nets for limits of Dungeness crab for his customers.



#### RECIPE OF THE MONTH – JANUARY 2026

#### MARINATED CRACKED CRAB

##### INGREDIENTS

2 cooked crabs  
3/4 cup extra virgin olive oil  
1/3 cup Italian parsley chopped very fine  
1 jar of Christopher Ranch Chopped Garlic


##### INSTRUCTIONS

Break off claws and legs from crab and crack with nutcracker. Pull off backs and remove all parts. Pull off small piece of shell and mouth of crab and discard. Rinse body of crab in cold water to remove excess fat. Cut body of crab in half. Place cracked claws, legs and crab bodies in a large Tupperware container. Marinate crab by adding some of the chopped garlic, chopped parsley and olive oil, to your desired taste. Cover Tupperware and shake to mix all ingredients together. Check for your desired taste and add more garlic, parsley and olive oil if necessary. Place covered Tupperware into the refrigerator for a minimum of 4 hours, overnight is preferred. Serve with French bread and your favorite white wine. Enjoy...
